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Roulez vert Program

REBATE FOR THE INSTALLATION OF EV CHARGERS IN MULTI-UNIT RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS

Who is eligible?

- Condo boards
- Building managers
- Real estate developers
- Multi-unit residential building owner

Is EV ownership required?

No

What are the financial incentives?

Number of dwelling units per building and maximum amount allocated per year:

3 to 9	10 to 19	20 or more
20 000 \$	40 000 \$	49 000 \$

Delays are to be expected in the processing of rebate applications

Which buildings qualify?

New or existing builds that:

- have a minimum of three dwelling units
- are located in Quebec
- are residential, or mixed residential properties



Which EV chargers are eligible?

Chargers that are:

- Level 2 (208/240V AC)
- Maintained in service for a minimum of three years

What's the financial incentive?

The lesser of the following amounts: 50% of eligible expenses OR 5 000 \$ per charger.

Do the chargers have to be for residents' use only?

Eligible chargers may be used by visitors to the eligible applicant if priority of access remains with residents.



What are the eligible expenses?

Labour

- Electrical
- Concrete scans and drill work
- Excavation

Materials

- Electric vehicle energy management systems
- New infrastructure
- Piping and wiring
- Cable trays
- EV chargers and pedestals

Others

- Professional service fees to design charging solutions and prepare the plans and specifications
- Cost of acquiring a device or software to manage the energy consumed to charge electric vehicles
- Cost of the permits required to carry out the installation work



How long will the program be in effect?

The program come into effect on April 18th, 2023, and will end on the occurrence of the first of the following events:

- the budget allocated to the program is fully committed; OR
- the Ministère de l'Environnement, de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques, de la Faune et des Parcs (MELCCFP) decides to terminate the program; OR
- the specified date on the [program's web page](#).
